

## Alien Medical Program (AMP) Fact Sheet

1. The revised and new WACS that govern AMP:
  - 388– 438-0110 Alien Medical (and Long Term) programs – overview
  - 388-438-0115 Alien Emergency Medical – federal funds
  - 388-438-0120 Alien Medical for Dialysis and Cancer Treatment – state funds
  - 388-438-0125 Alien Nursing Facility Program – state funds
2. To be eligible for AMP a person must be relatable to a Medicaid program except for Social Security number and citizenship requirements just as they were in the past. **However.....The emergent condition criteria have changed.** They must now have a qualifying medical condition as described in 388-438-0115 or 0120 or 0125.
3. Alien Emergency Medical (AEM 388-438-0115)
  - The service must be provided in a hospital setting: inpatient, outpatient surgery, emergency room **and**
  - HRSA medical consultant determines that the condition meets the emergency medical condition in WAC 388- 500-0005
  - Services under AEM will be limited to those needed to treat the emergency condition and must occur in the hospital setting
  - Certification for this program will be limited to the month in which the hospitalization occurred
4. Alien Medical for Dialysis and Cancer Treatment (AMDCT 388-4438-0120)
  - Surgery, chemotherapy, and/or radiation therapy to treat cancer or
  - Dialysis to treat acute renal failure or end stage renal disease or
  - Anti-rejection medication if the person has had an organ transplant
  - And**
  - HRSA medical consultant must approve that the client is actively in a treatment plan
  - Services will be limited to those needed to treat cancer, renal failure, end stage renal disease or anti-rejection medication. Treatment **is not** limited to a hospital setting.
  - Certification for this program will range between 1 and 12 months depending on the qualifying condition approved by HRSA medical consultant.
5. Alien Nursing Facility Program (388-438-0125)
  - Have prior approval authorization by ADSA
  - Meet all other eligibility factors for nursing home placement
  - All clients under this program will be approved by ADSA – subject to caseload limits
  - Clients will receive full categorically needy scope of care
  - Certification will be for 12 months
6. AEM or AMDCT can't be approved until you receive approval back from the medical consultant
